 - ② For public junior high school Resident in Toshima City and will graduate from elementary school on March 31, 2024.
 - (* You must apply even when your children graduate from Toshima public elementary school and enter Toshima public junior high school.)

School your children will attend

We will designate the school by the area where you live.

Tuition fees, textbooks & other expenses

Tuition fees, lunch fees, and textbooks are free of charge. School supplies, outings, study trips, gym uniforms, indoor shoes, and uniforms (junior high school only) should be paid for by the parent/guardian.

Toshima City has a School Financial Assistance System to cover some of the school expenses for parent/guardian who lives in Toshima and is having financial difficulty. If you want to apply, please fill in the application form for school financial assistance, which we will distribute after school starts, and turn it in to the Board of Education, Toshima City Office.

Japanese language lesson

There are Japanese lessons for children whose Japanese ability is not enough. They can learn Japanese along with daily living habits.

Children below are encouraged to take lessons:

- Children who recently arrived in Japan and do not understand Japanese.
- Children who do not understand what teachers are talking about or do not understand Japanese words in textbooks.

(Schools with the teachers of Japanese language)

Children can receive Japanese lessons from the teachers with the permission of the school principal. Please consult with the principal after school starts.

[Japanese class at Education Center]

If your children do not enroll in any of the above five schools and arrive in Japan less than six months ago, they can take lessons at the Education Center (3-1-7 Zoshigaya, Toshima-ku). Please consult with the principal after school starts. Please be aware that taking your children to and from the Education Center is your responsibility.
